



Table Saw

- Keep work area clean.
- Be sure available dust collection system is operating.
- Before you begin:
 - Inspect workpiece for nails, screws, knots, etc.
 - Inspect mounting flanges for damage and proper size.
 - Replace broken, dull, cracked, or fouled saw blades.
 - Be sure spreader and anti-kickback dogs are properly positioned and functional.
- Use proper saw blade for material being cut.
- Use push sticks or blocks whenever possible.
- Follow manufacturer requirements for cutting ferrous and nonferrous metals.

Note: Immediately report all machinery malfunctions to the supervisor.
